ENCOUNTER WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; Acts 1:8

The youth convention was a powerful and transformative gathering of youngsters where the presence of God moved mightily, encouraging them in their faith. **Br. Jaison Joseph** from Melbourne was invited to minister. The morning session began with prayer and praises to the Almighty, expecting a deep encounter with the Holy Spirit. The children experienced God in a way they had never experienced before. They were baptized with the Holy Spirit and saw visions as they began to lift their hands in surrender, overwhelmed by the love of Christ. It was evident that they advanced in their relationship with Jesus Christ.

The evening session marked its beginning with praise and worship led by our youth choir. The Shekinah glory of God filled the space and was tangible in our midst. The word of God reminded us that the Holy Spirit is a friend, comforter, and guide and desires a close relationship with us. God grants His Holy Spirit in great measure if we have a desire.

Being filled with the Holy Spirit often throws a question: **Has the Holy Spirit received you?** Empowerment by the Holy Spirit's anointing will change our perception and spirit. David and Caleb were quoted as the epitome of biblical characters with a different spirit. They confronted the people, as they had great faith in God's promises. This message resonated deeply that God was not looking for perfection

but a willingness to say, **"Here I am, Lord, send me"**. The crowd was challenged to reflect a similar perception in ministry irrespective of our abilities, talents, or qualifications. The insights from the story of Elijah and the widow at Zarephath, that the flow of the oil stopped only when there were no more vessels to receive it and to slam the door completely from the world before the oil is transferred, are proof that God always intended everyone to have access to His saving grace. What is inside becomes valuable when there is a vessel to hold it. We should be the vessels to contain the anointing. The question Will you be that person for God to use in this city? invaded the hearts of the audience. The core takeaway was to

- Be an empty vessel that desires to be filled with the spirit of the living God.
- Be available vessels for God.
- Desire more of Him and less of us.
- Bring what we have to the Lord without hesitation.
- Be an appointed vessel to rise and conquer the city.
- Be a surrendered vessel that allows the Spirit to work.

When the altar call was given, the youth made their way to the front and decided to follow Jesus and walk as God intended, the powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit continued touching lives and healing brokenness. A few children surrendered their lives to Jesus and decided to get baptized. That wasn't just a momentary emotional experience, but a true encounter instilling renewed purpose and passion for Christ Jesus.

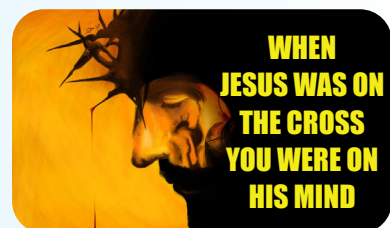
FATHER'S LOVE

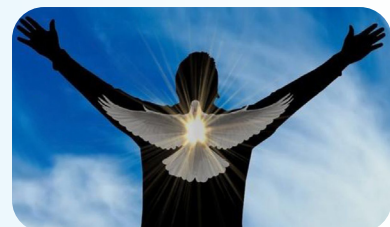
THE GRACE OF OUR LORD JESUS

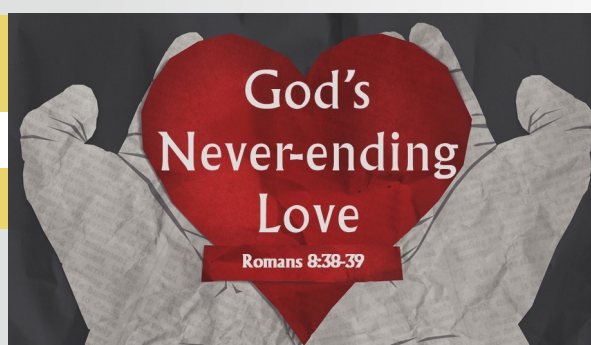

YOUTH OUTREACH



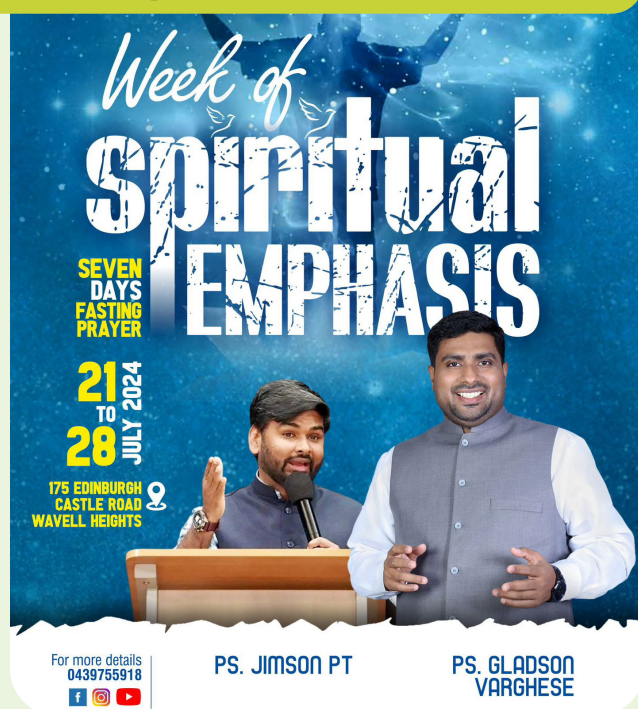
