# Faithfulness of God

The literal meaning of **faithfulness** is “the everlasting loyalty and trustworthiness in relationships”. “Joshua 21:45” portrays this definition in the fulfillment of all God’s promises to Israel, even though they were unfaithful to Him throughout their exodus.” II Timothy 2:13” reflects the same revelation as ‘if we are faithless, He remains faithful’. As we proclaim, “God is faithful all the time”, this implies the unchanging love of God, depicted throughout the scriptures. His ultimate faithfulness was shown on the cross as His unfailing love for the wretched human like each one of us.

***While “God is faithful all the time” how can we be faithful to Him?***

Faithfulness can be referred to as “fullness

of faith”. Faith is “the confirmation of the unseen things” “Hebrews 11:1”. Seeing the unseen God as Moses in Horeb reflects the realization of the abidance of the Holy Spirit in our human body. The presence of God with us 24/7 will derive fear of God, to avoid our sinful life by promoting spiritually right choices in the eyes of our Lord. “The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom (the ability to make right choices)”. Similarly, complete obedience to the word of God refers to faithfulness to our Heavenly Father.

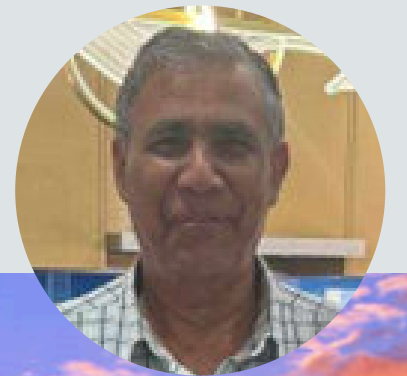
# God's faithfulness to a faithful seeker

Through her faith, love, and obedience, Ruth becomes a significant woman in Israel's history, on a par with Leah and Rachel, who built up the twelve tribes. Similarly, Boaz became Ruth’s redeemer; Jesus will redeem us and take us home to be with Him forever. Let’s eagerly wait for Him!

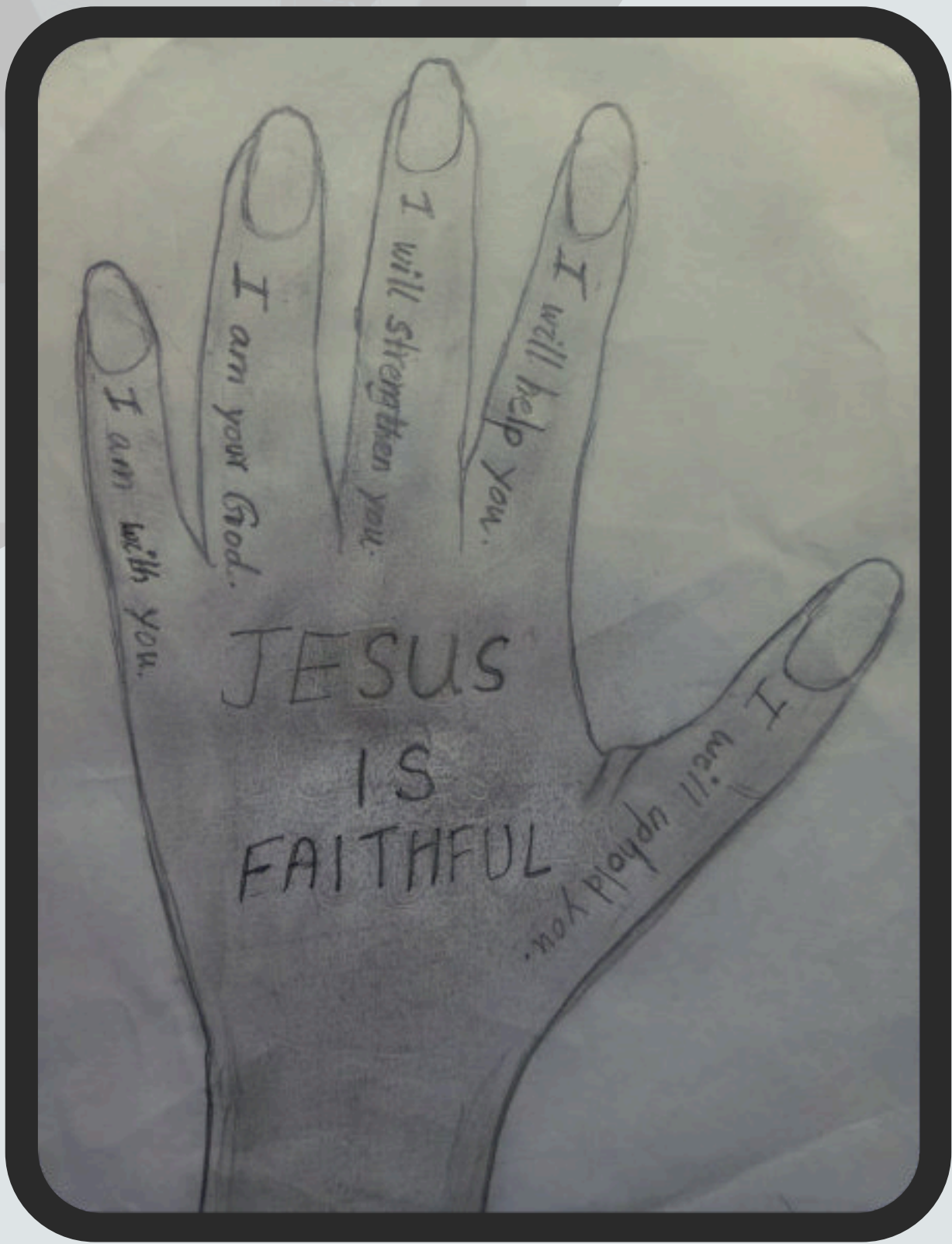
